Overall – Define “school safety” & the standard list of safety related services provided by every ESD. Define the services that are in addition to the standard services. Define the long range fiscal plan to sustain standard and additional services provided by each RSSC.

<p><i>Within the region</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement school-level, district level and county/regional level TA teams. • Train and consult with school and district TA teams regarding threats, violence, and management of situations and students of concern. • Coordinate, facilitate and serve as member of the monthly case staffing(s) multi-agency TA team/teams. • Conduct school level TA as needed with members of the school (investigative) team. • Assist schools in threat management, safety planning, intervention, and resource development. • Prepare and provide information to schools to disseminate information to staff, parents, students and community members about the multitier TA system. • Facilitate cross SD and multi-agency communication with key school TA team, law enforcement and other community groups as applicable to coordinate support and safety for students. 	<p><i>Within the Region</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School Mapping System (see PP). Conduct a Systems inventory (state-wide) within each region. • Explore the use of the school mapping system to facilitate school notification. • Survey local schools, including private schools to learn what currently is in place, how this information is disseminated to students and parents, and how it is monitored. • Connect with WSRMP and Clear Risk to learn what notification system is currently in place, how this information is disseminated to students and parents, and how it is monitored. What schools (including private are connected to the notification system) • Work with local law enforcement on communications with schools when responding to threats and a lock down is required. Help if needed with linkages to schools (including private schools) and law enforcement to establish a notification/warning communications of safety emergencies if needed. 	<p><i>Within the Region</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Define “safety technology”. • Identify what is currently in place and what the gaps are (if any) for safety technology needs. • Develop a list of specific services/resources available for safety technology that could be used by SDs. • Host one School Mapping training for the local school district safety directors and other staff.
<p><i>ESD State-wide focus</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Host monthly/bi monthly professional learning community for ESD & school district TA coordinators to network and consult across the state. • Provide training materials and may assist in training (1 per ESD) so other ESD’s can build their own capacity to support the implementation of a multitier TA system. • Collect and prepares report data for AESD and to Student Support Directors on progress. 	<p><i>ESD State-wide support</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitate a state-wide school mapping inventory, identify gaps and a multi-year plan for deployment and sustainment training • Create and share survey tool used to gather information • Collect and prepare report data for AESD and to Student Support Directors on identified gaps (within the region), recommendations, and progress. 	<p><i>ESD State-wide support</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect and prepare report data for AESD and to Student Support Directors on identified gaps (within the region), recommended vendors, and progress. • Provide linkages to other ESD to host School Mapping training for the local school district safety directors and other staff.
